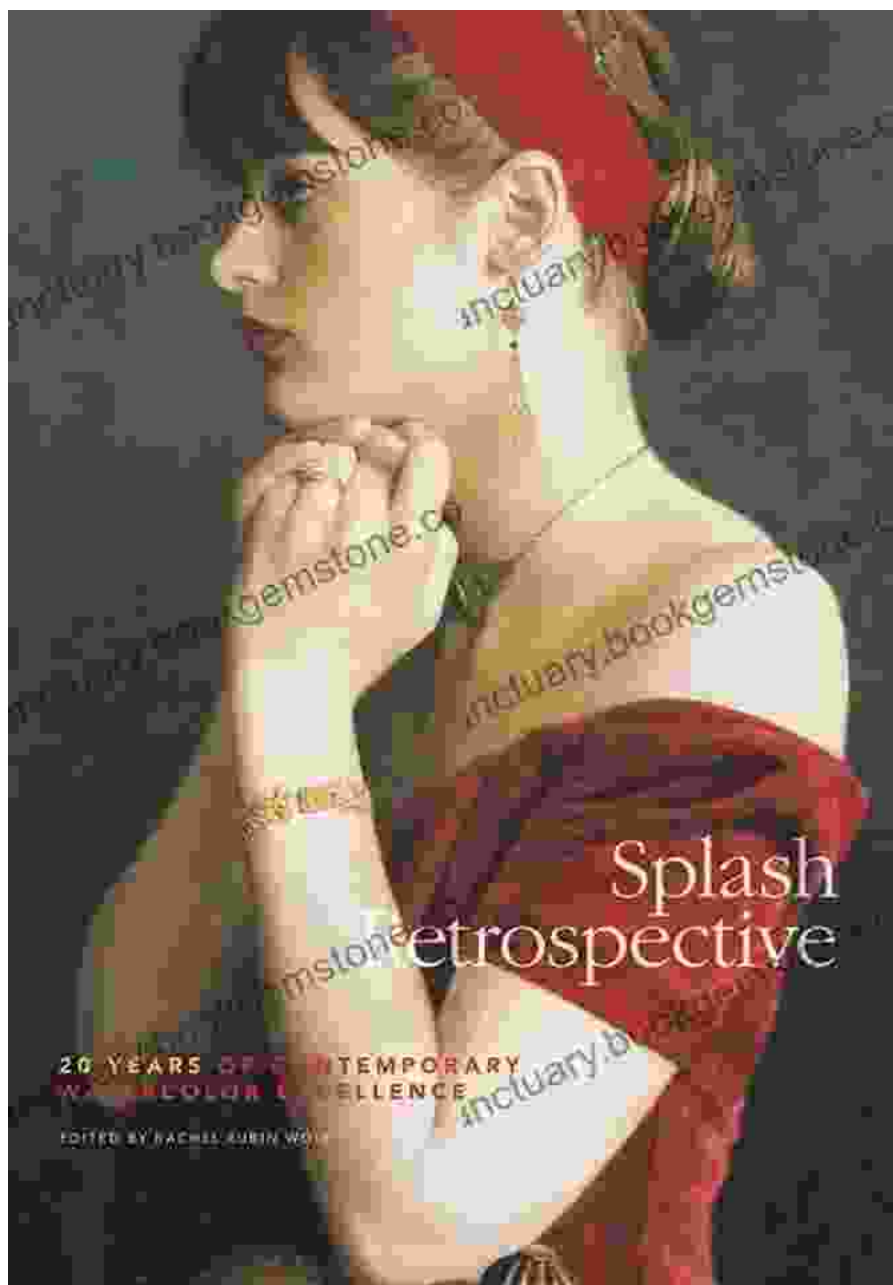

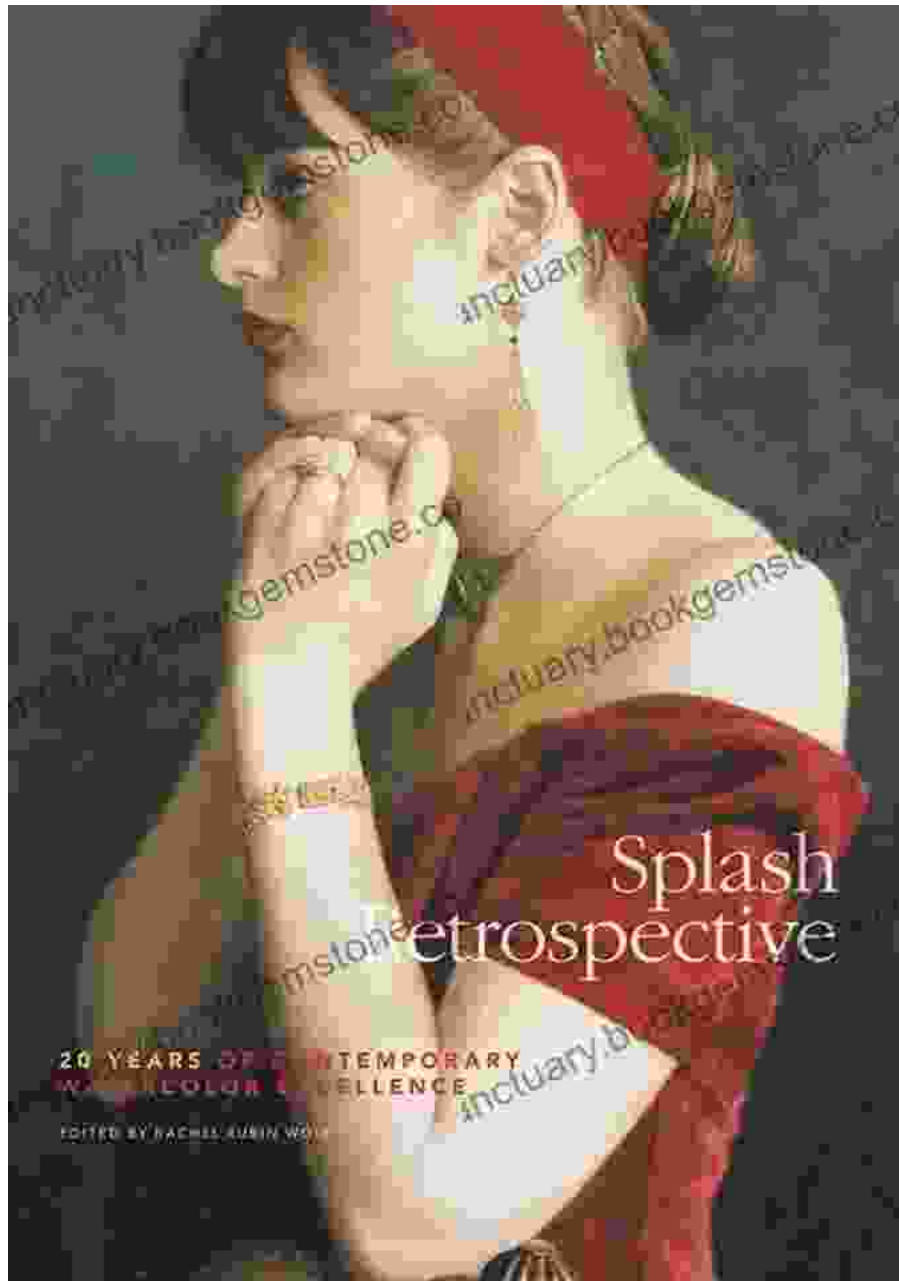
The Works

Splash is a unique opportunity to see some of the best watercolor paintings being created today. The exhibition is a celebration of the medium's past, present, and future.

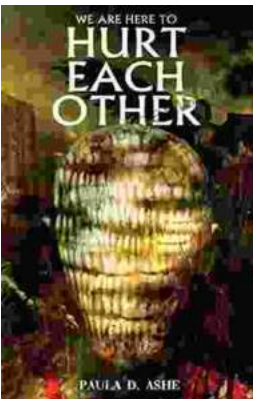

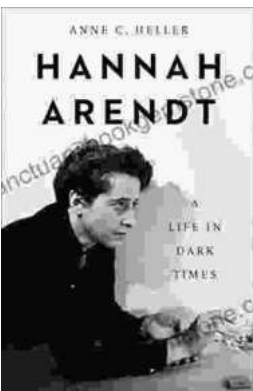
