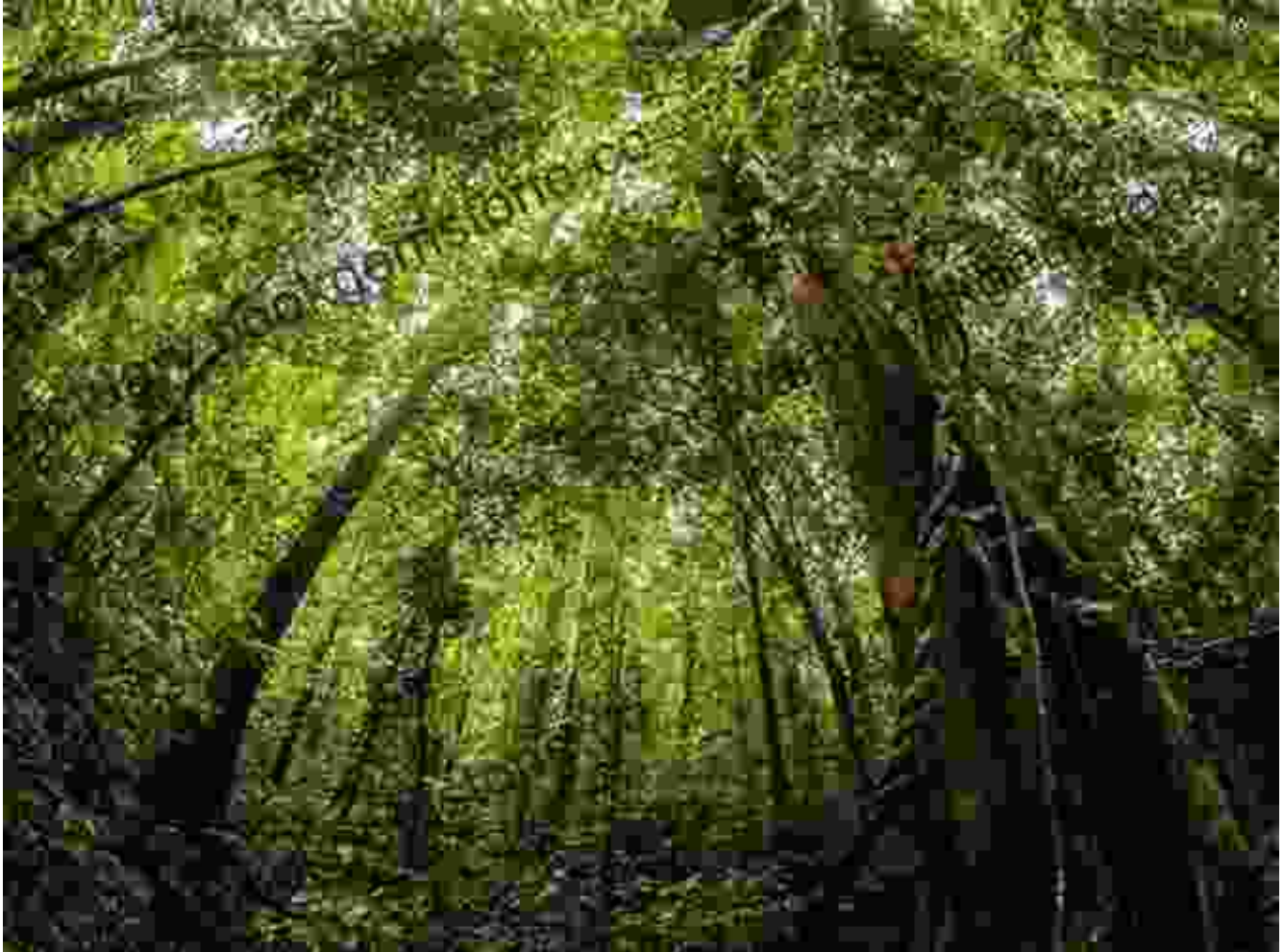


## Rainforests

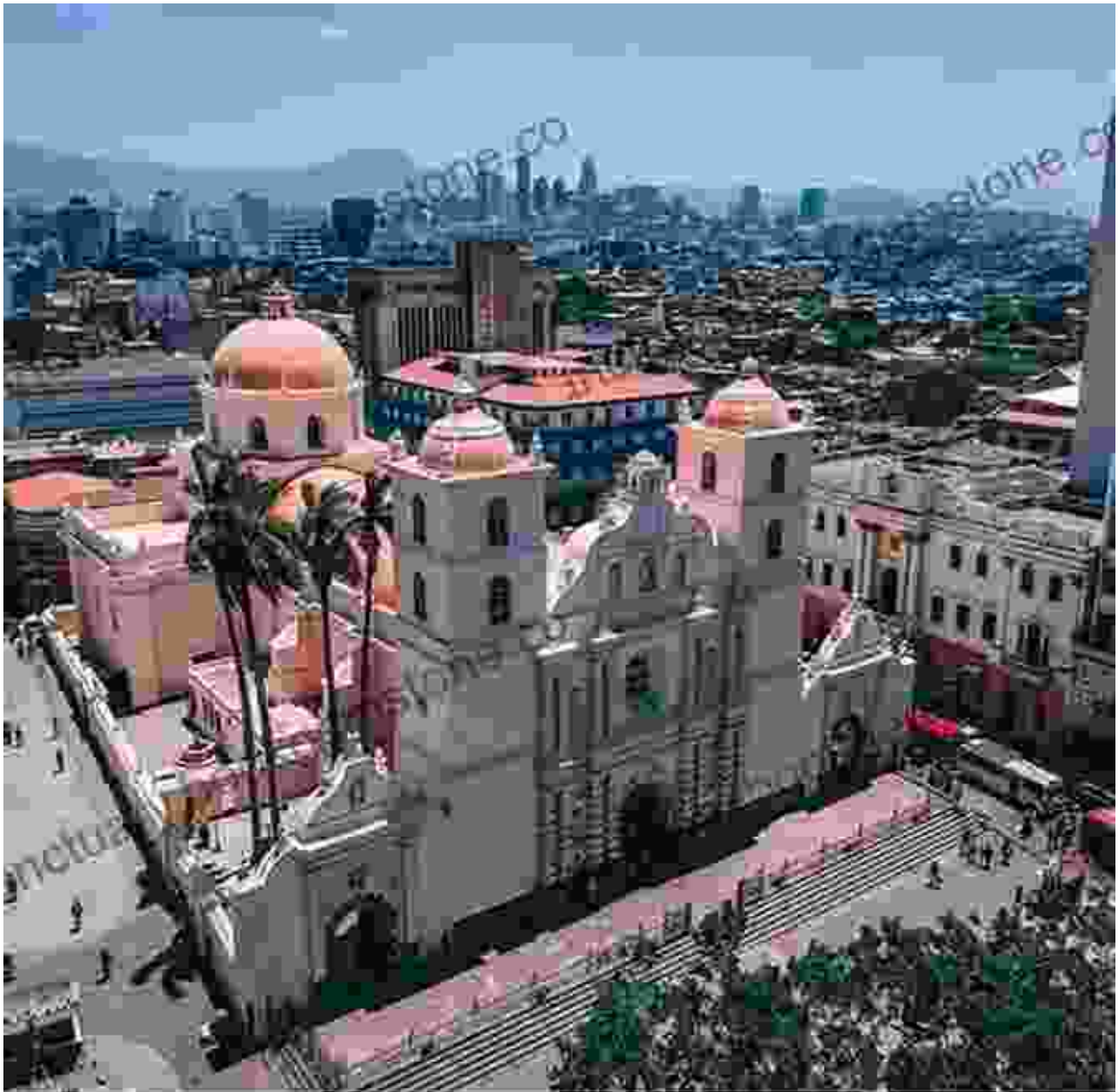

- **Accommodation:** There is a wide range of accommodation options available in Honduras, from budget hostels to luxury resorts. You can find something to fit your budget and needs.

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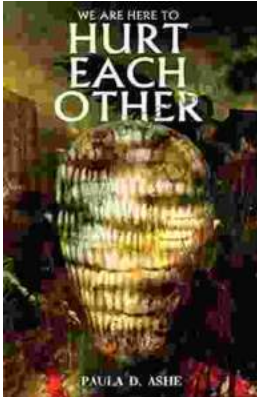
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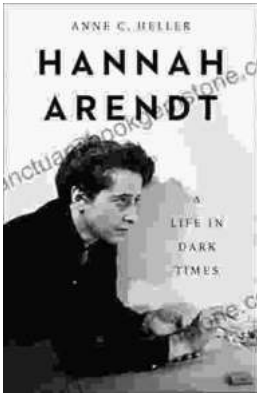
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
